The Navajo Preparatory School, Inc. operates a college preparatory program that serves talented and highly motivated Native American Youth preparing for college. The academic program provides to approximately 200 students from grades 9th -12th. Our program utilizes advanced teaching methods and strategies in a dynamic learning environment.

Students are selected based on a comprehensive screening process. Admissions criteria includes a strong performance on the entrance exam, personal essay, recommendation forms, GPA of 3.0 or above and an interview with NPS Staff.
